

Interclub Competition

Rules for 2011-2012



In each of the last five years digital files have been competing directly with 35mm slides in the same competition. This is the first year that our competition has eliminated slides and is totally a digital competition. The following text explains the rules of entry.

Rules:

- Entries are not limited as to subject matter or treatment but they must be the work of a bona fide resident club member. No person may have more than two digital files entered in any one competition month, even though a member of more than one registered club. In the event of excessive entries by one person all files entered by that person will be disqualified. Award of Merit and Honorable Mention images may never again be entered and if re-entered will be disqualified. **Identical or near-duplicate slides or digital files may not be entered in the same season. Disqualified slides or digital files will not receive points.**
- Digital entries must be uploaded on our webpage. Largest size 1024 (Max on the horizontal dimension) x 768 (max on the vertical dimension) pixels at a resolution of 300 pixels per inch ... that's 1024x768! The uploading program will not accept your images if they exceed these limits.
- **The file naming process will be done automatically when your images are uploaded on our webpage.** But it would be helpful if you use this naming protocol ... an image submitted by Kristina Erin Kaye of the Cranbury Digital Camera Club in Group A, titled "Mockingbird with Berry" could be uploaded as this → A-MOCKINGBIRD WITH BERRY-by Kristina Kaye-CRANBURY ←

This will make for easier access for me when I do the annual BOB DVD.

- Please don't use _ between words, please leave a space only.
- The Closing Date for all 4 competitions is the 1st of that month. The judging club can judge the entries anytime with the Competition month. If a club's entry arrives after the deadline, the club will generally have the privilege of submitting a makeup entry in the next competition. **Makeup entries are now eligible for awards.** Only 1 make-up is permitted per season.
